5. Memorize

Memorize the meaning of the following tags and questions to visitors.

- **R'nR stands for Read and Rewrite**

You read a passage of scripture from your daily reading plan and pick out a verse that really stuck out to you. Read it again and then rewrite it in your journal. Sometimes you may want to write it in your own words and sometimes you may want to write it word for word. Then, you might want to write how it applies to your life. This helps the verse become personal to you and helps you really remember it.

- **M'nM stands for Memorize and Meditate.**

We don't memorize to memorize, we memorize to meditate. We memorize scripture so that it will be with us wherever we go and we can always be thinking about it.

- **J12 stands for Jesus |at| 12.**

Luke chapter 2 tells the story of when Jesus was 12 years old and in the temple (house of God). His parents had been searching for him for 3 days and when they found him he said 7 words - "I must be about My Father's business." This is God's plan for all of us. To be like Jesus was at 12 and know the Father's plans for our lives.

- **T'nT stands for Tests and Testimonies.**

We tell the stories of what the Lord has done in our lives, prayers that He has answered, and what has happened as a result of knowing and walking with Him.

- **P'nC stands for Prayer and Confession.**

Sometimes you pray the scripture and confess it because it is truth.
