## Consultation Information

As you may have read in our literature, J12 is more of a philosophy or set of values by which our services are structured, rather than specific curriculum or teaching. Therefore, each expression of J12 is unique within the DNA of the church in which it is functioning, yet still holds the same philosophy or values of the ministry of J12.

We have received consistent requests, phone calls and emails for answers to questions and information on exactly how to do J12 in your local church. We have found it challenging to be able to effectively give counsel or advise without knowing many of the variables your particular church is dealing with. Each church situation is so unique, it is difficult, if not impossible, to implement exactly the same program in the same way and expect it to work with maximum efficiency for that particular church and its' particular situation.

Because of this great need, we are now offering a personal consulting plan to those of you who are interested in having J12 in your church. Here is how it works:

We give you an extensive questionnaire regarding many of the specifics of your church. For example: What is the vision and mission of your church? Are you more inreach or outreach or a combination of both? What is your philosophy of staffing for kid's church, volunteer or paid? What is the volunteer structure in other ministries at the church? In what type of community is your church located? Do you have activities that connect your church to your community? Does your community have any ministries unique to that area? What types of giftings are in your church? What other areas of ministry do you have? Are there adults involved in other outside ministries?

This questionnaire will give us specifics on how to craft a specific ministry plan that will help your church and your kids best express the heart of Jesus at 12, and live the seven words, which are, "I must be about My Father's business." Our team will review it and come up with an initial plan for your church. Jessica Johnson and another member from the team will then come to your church to meet with your leaders discussing and revising the plan as we gather further information and ideas from your team. We would like to meet on a Friday evening and Saturday. The evening would allow for assessment and give us knowledge as to the greatest areas of need to focus on for Saturday. Your leader will then receive a Master Plan Book with all the information talked about and discussed. There will also be an opportunity to have a conference call with your team once a month for progress reports. Working together, we believe J12 can have a unique expression in your church and community.

\* For very small churches, there could be a possibility of "bundling". This would only be for churches with less than 15 kids in the J12 age range and would be limited to up to five churches holding a seminar together. Very small churches have limited variables to deal with. Therefore, I believe we could come up with a fairly comprehensive "starter" plan for these churches, giving them basic direction and tools to begin building their ministry as well as serve those who are already there. Please note: These churches would not be eligible for the monthly conference call unless they are able to work together and utilize the conference call for all churches comprehensively.

The costs for these services are as follows:
